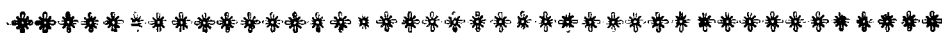

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums of Money A.D. 1882.
 arising from the Sale of certain Escheated
 Estates. [6 November, 1882.]

BE. it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the sum of Four hundred and thirteen pounds eleven shillings and sixpence (£413 11s. 6d.) standing in the Books of the Treasurer to the credit of the Escheated Estates of *Matthew Moore*, *James Brady*, *John Dillon*, and *Christopher Ley Howell*, there shall be paid by the said Treasurer the sums following:—

2 The said Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be payable out of the said sum of Four hundred and thirteen pounds eleven shillings and sixpence (£413 11s. 6d.)

Credit to be given
to the Treasurer
in Account.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
