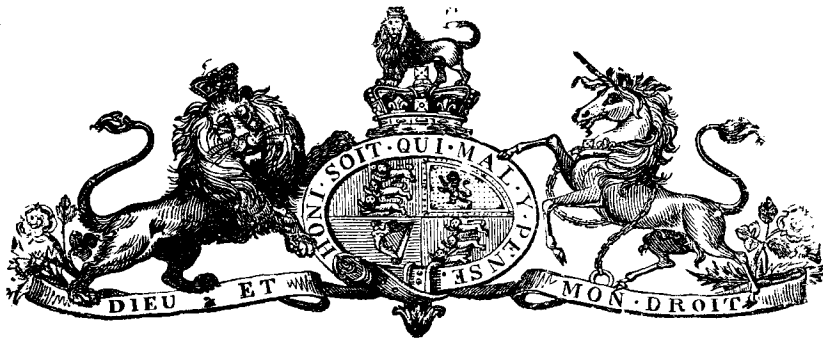

AN ACT to authorise *James Barnard* to claim A.D. 1899.  
the Benefit of *The Superannuation Act* upon  
his Retirement from the Public Service of  
*Tasmania*. [22 December, 1899.]

WHEREAS *James Barnard* entered the Public Service of PREAMBLE.  
*Tasmania* in the month of *May*, One thousand eight hundred and  
sixty-three, without pay :

And whereas the said *James Barnard* continued in the Public  
Service without pay until the Fifth day of *May*, One thousand eight  
hundred and sixty-four, when he was appointed an officer in the  
Customs Department in *Launceston* :

And whereas the said *James Barnard* has continued in the Customs  
Department of *Tasmania* until the present time, and now holds the  
office of Secretary for Customs under "The Customs Act, 1897 : "

And whereas *The Abolition of Pensions Act* was passed on the  
Thirtieth day of *July*, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three,  
which provides that no person entering the Public Service after that  
date shall be entitled to a pension :

And whereas doubts have arisen whether the said *James Barnard* can claim the benefit of *The Superannuation Act* upon his retirement from the Public Service :

And whereas it is desirable that such doubts should be removed by legislative enactment :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** It is hereby declared that the said *James Barnard* is entitled to the benefit of *The Superannuation Act* upon his retirement from the Public Service of the Colony, subject, however, to all the provisions of the said Act.
