

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated A.D. 1887. Revenue Fund the Sum of One hundred and fifty Thousand Pounds to the Service of the Three Months ending the Thirtieth day of September, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Issue and ap there shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the Service of plication of the Three Months ending the Thirtieth day of September, One thousand £150,000. eight hundred and eighty-seven, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of One hundred and fifty Thousand Pounds: Proposed that he appropriate for any Establishment or Service by mode in vided, that no payments for any Establishment or Service be made in excess of the rates voted for similar Establishments or Services on the Estimates for the half-year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor. 2 The Treasurer of the Colony shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes herein before mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Credit to be given in Treasurer's Accounts. 3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
