AN ACT to authorise the Payment of certain Sums of Money to the Municipal Councils of *Deloraine* and *Oatlands* for the Purchase of Recreation Grounds.

A.D. 1889.

[5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the year 1889 there shall and may be appropriated and paid to the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Deloraine* the sum of One hundred and seventy-two Pounds for and towards the purchase of a Public Recreation Ground in or near the Town of *Deloraine*.

Appropriation of £172 to Municipal Council of *Deloraine*.

2 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the year 1889 there shall and may be appropriated and paid to the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Oatlands* the sum of One hundred and forty-two Pounds for and towards the purchase of a Public Recreation Ground in or near the Town of *Oatlands*.

Appropriation of £142 to Municipal Council of *Oatlands*.

Moneys payable
by Warrant of

3 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums to each of such Municipal Councils respectively for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such day as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, orders and directs ; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year 1889.

Credit to be given
to the Treasurer
in account.

4 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for such sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid ; and the receipt of each of such Municipal Councils shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

5 The said sums of money shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent, or purpose other than those mentioned.
