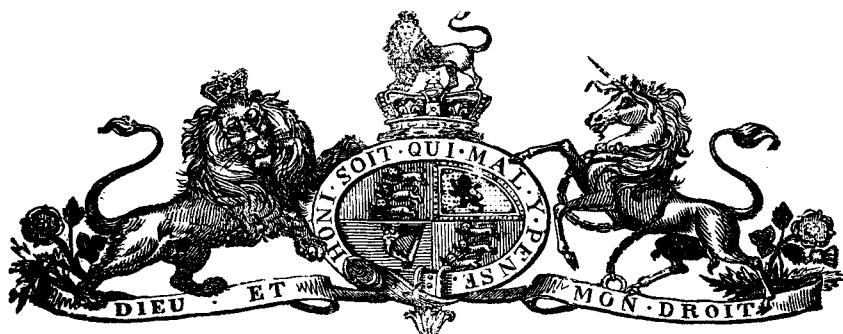

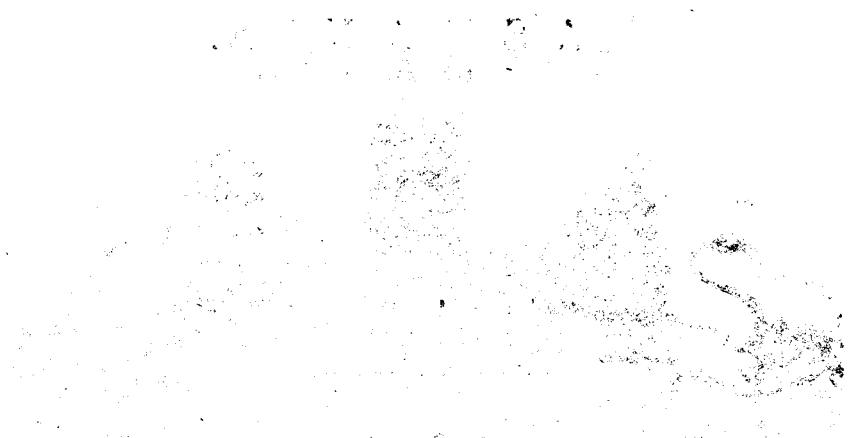
AN ACT to afford Relief to Purchasers of Crown Land under the Credit Clauses of *The Waste Lands Act, 1863.* [21 December, 1871.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend the term within which certain purchasers of Crown Land upon Credit may pay for such Land: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that in every case in which any part of the purchase money of any land not exceeding One hundred and twenty-five Acres, purchased on Credit from the Crown before the Seventeenth day of *September*, 1868, remains unpaid, the Commissioner of Crown Lands shall, upon the application of the Purchaser within Three calendar months from the First day of *January*, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, extend credit for any instalments which may at the time of such application be due, and for all remaining instalments, until the first day of *May*, 1873: Provided, however, that such purchaser shall, before he enters upon the extended term of credit granted by this Act, forthwith pay to the Colonial Treasurer interest at the rate of Five pounds *per centum per annum* upon every instalment to which such extension of credit shall apply, such interest to be paid in advance; and in every case in which such credit is authorised to be extended as hereinbefore provided no forfeiture shall be deemed to have occurred by reason of any default having been made before the expiration of the time hereinbefore provided for any purchaser to apply for extended credit, and the land shall not be deemed to have reverted to the Crown, anything in *The Waste Lands Act* to the contrary notwithstanding, unless such land shall have been, after forfeiture under the provisions of the said Act, again sold by the Commissioner of Crown Lands before this Act comes into operation.

PREAMBLE.

Purchaser of not more than 125 Acres of land on Credit prior to 17th *September*, 1868, entitled to extended Credit upon application, and payment of interest.
