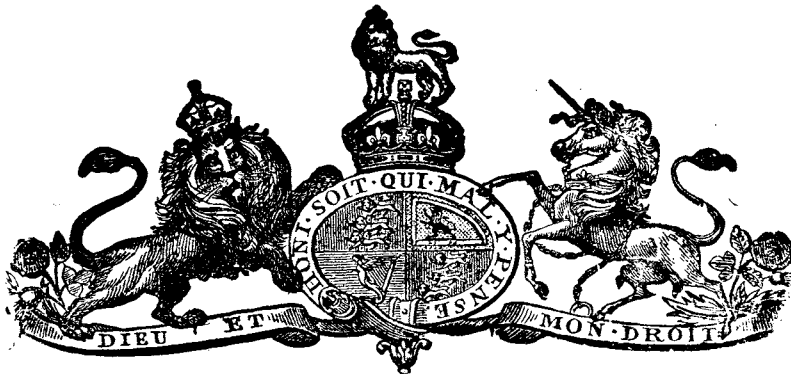

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 7 Ed. VII. No. 20.
2. Amendment of Section 11 of Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend "The State Advances Act, 1907." A.D. 1914.
[6 February, 1915.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The State Advances Act, 1914," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The State Advances Act, 1907," in this Act referred to as the Principal Act, and every Act amending the same. Short title and incorporation with 7 Ed. VII. No. 20.

2 Section Eleven of the Principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from Subsection (1) thereof the words "Fifty thousand Pounds," and substituting therefor the words "One hundred thousand Pounds." Amendment of Section 11 of Principal Act.
