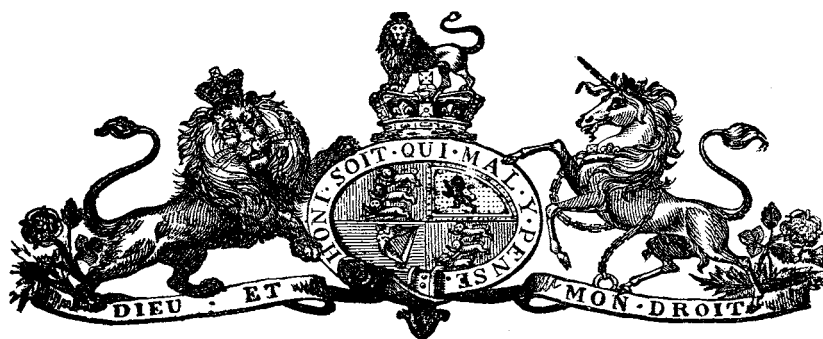

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1885.  
certain Moneys for the Construction of  
certain Streets at *Hobart* and *Launceston*.  
[5 December; 1885.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand seven hundred and fifty Pounds (£3750), in and towards the construction and improvement of certain outlying Streets within the said City. £3750 to be payable to Municipal Council of Hobart for construction, &c. of certain Streets.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the Town of *Launceston* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds (£2500), in and towards the construction and improvement of certain outlying Streets within the said Town. £2500 to be payable to Municipal Council of Launceston for construction, &c. of certain Streets.

**3** No moneys shall be payable under this Act unless the said Councils respectively shall submit to the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being such particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the several works proposed to be performed as the Minister deems to be necessary, and the Governor in Council shall approve of the same.

**4** Upon the receipt by the said Treasurer from time to time of a certificate by the Town Surveyor of the said City and Town respectively that any such works or any part thereof have been well and properly performed, and stating the total cost of the same, there shall be payable to the said Councils respectively under this Act such sum or sums of money as the Governor in Council may approve, not exceeding two-thirds of the total cost of any such work, and not exceeding in the whole the respective sums of money hereinbefore mentioned: Provided that every such certificate shall be approved by the Mayor of the said City and Town respectively prior to the same being transmitted to the Treasurer as herein provided.
