

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of a A.D. 1882. Sum of £20,000 for effecting certain Improvements in the Rivers North Esk and Tamar at [6 November, 1882.] Launceston.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to "The Launceston Marine Board" any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds (£20,000), in and towards the Tamar. Dredging and other Improvements in the Rivers North Esh and Tamar at Launceston.

- 2 No moneys shall be payable under this Act unless the said Marine No moneys to be Board shall submit to the Minister of Lands and Works for the time paid unless being such particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the works particulars, &c. of proposed to be performed as the Minister deems necessary, and the works furnished Governor in Council shall approve of the same.

3 Upon the receipt by the said Treasurer from time to time of a Treasurer to pay certificate by the Engineer-in-Chief that any such works or any part money upon thereof have been well and properly performed, and stating the total cost of the same there shall be payable to the said Board under this Act. of the same, there shall be payable to the said Board under this Act Chief. such sum or sums of money as the Governor in Council may approve, not exceeding two-thirds of the total cost of any such work or any part thereof, and not exceeding in the whole the said sum of Twenty thousand Pounds (£20,000).
