By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council.

AN ACT to amend the Act of Council intituled "An "Act for rendering a Release as effectual for the Con-"veyance of Freehold Estates as a Lease and Release "by the same Parties."

[5th August, 1853.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council of the said Island, that it shall not be necessary for any Deed or Instrument of Release of a Freehold Estate, or any Deed or Instrument purporting or intended so to be, to be expressed to be made in pursuance of the Act of Council, intituled An Act for rendering a Release as effectual for the Conveyance of Freehold Estates as a Lease and Release by the same Parties; but every Deed or Instrument of Release of a Freehold Estate, or Deed or Instrument purporting or intended so to be, shall take effect as provided by the said recited Act, without the Insertion of any Reference to the said Act; and every such Deed or Instrument of Release as aforesaid, which has been made since the said recited Act came into operation, and in which such Reference to the said recited Act as is by such Act required has been omitted, shall, notwithstanding such Omission, be and be deemed to be and to have 17 VICT. No. 2.

Releases of Frecholds need not refer to 7 Vict. No. 3.

Releases already made declared valid notwithstanding Omission of such Reference.
