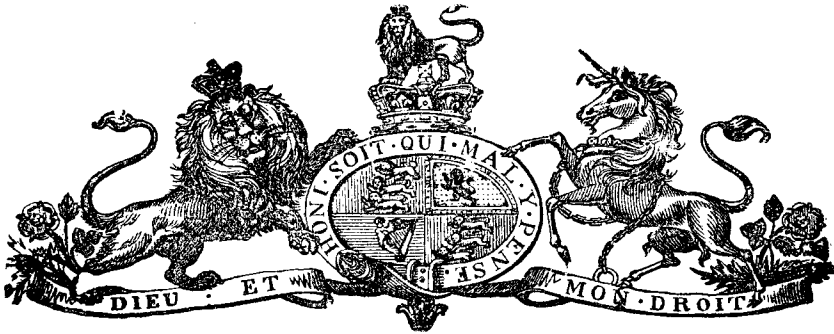

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1887.
certain Moneys for the Construction and
Improvement of Streets of *Hobart* and *Launceston*.
[20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Four thousand Pounds (£4000), in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said City: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof of the sum which has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said City; and on receipt by the Treasurer of such satisfactory proof he shall pay a sum equal to one-half of such amount so expended as aforesaid.

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the Town of *Launceston* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand Pounds, in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof of the sum which has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town; and that on the receipt by the Treasurer of such satisfactory proof the Treasurer shall pay a sum equal to one-half of such amount so expended as aforesaid.
