

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1887. certain Moneys for the Construction and Improvement of Streets of Hobart and Laun-[20 December, 1887.] ceston.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be pro- £4000 to be vided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the payable to Muni-Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart* any sum or sums of money cipal Council of the exceeding in the whole the sum of Four thousand Pounds (£4000), struction, &c. of in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within Streets. the said City: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof of the sum which has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said City; and on receipt by the Treasurer of such satisfactory proof he shall pay a sum equal to one-half of such amount so expended as aforesaid.

Appropriation for Streets, Hobart & Launceston.

A.D. 1887.

£3000 to be payable to Municipal Council of Launceston for construction, &c. of Streets.

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the Town of Launceston any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand Pounds, in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof of the sum which has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town; and that on the receipt by the Treasurer of such satisfactory proof the Treasurer shall pay a sum equal to one-half of such amount so expended as aforesaid.
