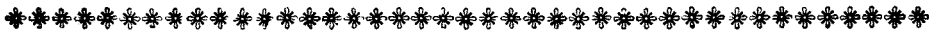

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of certain Moneys in aid of the Police Expenditure in certain Municipalities.

A.D. 1889.

[5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 There shall be payable by the Treasurer out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in the year 1890 to the Municipal Council of every Municipality in which a Police Rate of Ninepence in the Pound upon the annual value of the property within the Municipality shall be insufficient to defray the Police Expenditure for that year in such Municipality, a sum equal to the amount by which such Expenditure, or so much thereof as shall be certified by the Inspector of Police to be necessary, shall exceed the amount of such Rate in the same year: Provided that the total amount to be expended under this provision shall not exceed the sum of Three thousand five hundred Pounds.

Appropriation in aid of Police Expenditure in certain Municipalities.

2 No sum of money shall be payable or paid under the provisions of the last preceding Section to the Municipal Council of any Municipality which does not make and levy in the year 1890 a Police Rate of Ninepence in the Pound, and a Municipal Rate of Fourpence in the Pound, upon the annual value of the property within the Municipality.
