

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1890. certain Moneys in aid of the Road Rates in Road Districts and for other purposes. [28 *November*, 1890.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 There shall be payable by the Treasurer in the year 1891, out of Appropriation of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony for that year, any sum £12,000 towards or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Twelve thousand Road Districts. Pounds, for and towards the construction and repair of Roads and Bridges, other than Main Roads, and such money shall be payable to the Trustees of those Road Districts in which a Road Rate shall have been made and levied in the year ending on the Twenty-eighth day of February, 1891, in amounts proportionate to the total sums collected in that year as the proceeds of the Road Rate or Road Rates levied in that year in such Road Districts respectively:

Provided, that in no case shall there be paid to the Trustees of any Road District a sum greater than the proceeds of a Shilling Rate, nor greater than the sum collected by the Trustees of such Road District as the proceeds of any such Road Rate or Road Rates as aforesaid; and in no case shall any sum be paid to the Trustees of any Road District in which a Road Rate of Sixpence has not been levied and collected in

the year aforesaid:

Provided also, that no portion of the said sum of Twelve thousand Pounds shall be paid to the Trustees of any such Road District unless the Statement and Account for the preceding year of such Trustees, as required by "The Roads Act, 1884," are forwarded to the Auditor-General before the Thirty-first day of *March*, 1891.
