## AN ACT to alter the Designation of certain a.D. 1882 Responsible Ministers of the Crown in Tasmania.

Wthe British Colonies fulfilling the like duties to those performed by the Colonial Secretary and Colonial Treasurer in Tasmania, are styled the Chief Secretary and Treasurer, respectively, of the Colony in which they are such Ministers:

And whereas it is desirable that the Responsible Ministers of the Crown in Tasmania called the Colonial Secretary and Colonial Treasurer of Tasmania should be styled the Chief Secretary and Treasurer of Tasmania respectively :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 The Responsible Minister of the Crown in Tasmania called "the Colonial SecreColonial Secretary" shall, after the commencement of this Act, be styled tary to be styled "the Chief Secretary," and the Responsible Minister called "the Colonial Treasurer" shall, after the commencement of this Act, be styled "the Treasurer."

2 Where in any Act of the Legislature of Tasmania the expression "the Colonial Secretary" is used, the same shall after the commencement of this Act mean the Chief Secretary; and where in any such Act as foresaid the expression "the Colonial Treasurer" is used, the same shall after the commencement hereof mean "the Treasurer," anything contained in any Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
