AN ACT to amend *The Foreign Seamen Act.* [18 October, 1870.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend *The Foreign Seamen Act*: **PREAMBLE.**
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, **23 Vict. No. 8.**
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 No debt exceeding in amount Five Shillings, incurred by any Seaman after he has engaged to serve, shall be recoverable until the service agreed for is concluded. No debt exceeding Five Shillings recoverable till end of voyage.

2 This Act and *The Foreign Seamen Act* shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
