

AN ACT to authorise the issue of a Grant A.D. 1892. of a certain piece of Land to Mary Ann Sykes. [21 *December*, 1892.]

WHEREAS the Land described in the Schedule hereto was located PREAMBLE. to one John Sykes by virtue of a Land Certificate issued to him under the provisions of the Seventh Section of "The Immigration Act, 1867," and the said John Sykes is now entitled to have a Grant issued in respect of the said land:

And whereas the said John Sykes departed from Tasmania and left his wife Mary Ann Sykes and his children in Tasmania, and has not been heard of for many years:

And whereas it is desirable that a Grant of the said land should be

issued to the said Mary Ann Sykes:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 The Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Governor Her Majesty the Queen, to convey and alienate the land described in authorised to issue the Schedule hereto to the said Mary Ann Sykes in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest, under and subject to the various provisions contained in "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," and any Regulations in 54 Vict. No. 8. force at the passing of this Act, and made and published under the said Act or under any Act repealed by the said Act.

And upon the issue of a Grant of the said land to the said Mary Ann Sykes as hereinbefore provided, all the right, title, and interest of

the said John Sykes in and to the said land under and by virtue of a Land Certificate issued to him on the Seventeenth day of March, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, shall cease and determine, and the said Land Certificate shall thereupon be null and void.

SCHEDULE.

COUNTY OF DORSET. PARISH OF SCOTTSDALE.

Lot 5494. 100 Acres.

Bounded on the north by thirty-three chains and twenty-one links westerly along land purchased by Andrew M'Kenna commencing at a south-east angle thereof (crossing a reserved road one chain wide), on the west by thirty chains and seventy-two lines southerly along Crown land, on the south by thirty-one chains and seventy links easterly along land purchased by John Doherty to the before-mentioned reserved road, on the south east by two chains and thirty-three links north-easterly along that road, and thence on the east by twenty-nine chains and two links northerly also along that road (re-crossing the same) and along land purchased by Ellen Catherine Young to the point of commencement.
