AN ACT to authorise the issue of a Grant A.D. 1895.
of certain Land in the Town of *New Town*
to the Trustees of the Property of the
Church of *England* in *Tasmania*.

[27 September, 1895.]

WHEREAS the Church of *England* has for many years occupied PREAMBLE.
certain Crown Land in the Town of *New Town*, and has made
improvements thereon :

And whereas it is desirable that a Grant of a portion of such land
should be issued to the Trustees for the time being of the Property of
the Church of *England* in *Tasmania* :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Under and subject to the various provisions contained in “The Governor
Crown Lands Act, 1890,” and any Regulations made and published authorised to
thereunder, the Governor is hereby authorised in the name and on issue Grant for
behalf of Her Majesty to convey and alienate, in fee simple or for any land to Trustees
less estate or interest, a piece of land situate in the Town of *New* of Church
Town, in *Tasmania*, containing Five acres One rood and Twelve Property.
perches or thereabouts, to the Trustees for the time being of the Property 54 Viet. No. 8.
of the Church of *England* in *Tasmania*, such land being described in
the Schedule hereto.

BOUNDED on the north west by 7 chains and 50 links north-easterly along land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution now known as the Archery Ground commencing at the south angle thereof (crossing a cart road), on the north east by 6 chains 95½ links south-easterly along the last-mentioned land and along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution (crossing a carriage drive), on the south east by 7 chains and 44½ links south-westerly also along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution, and thence on the south west by 7 chains and 13 links north-westerly also along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution to the point of commencement.
