

AN ACT to authorise the issue of a Grant A.D. 1895. of certain Land in the Town of New Town to the Trustees of the Property of the Church of England in Tasmania.

[27 September, 1895.]

W HEREAS the Church of England has for many years occupied PREAMBLE. certain Crown Land in the Town of New Town, and has made improvements thereon:

And whereas it is desirable that a Grant of a portion of such land should be issued to the Trustees for the time being of the Property of

the Church of England in Tasmania:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Under and subject to the various provisions contained in "The Governor Crown Lands Act, 1890," and any Regulations made and published authorised to thereunder, the Governor is hereby authorised in the name and on land to Trustees behalf of Her Majesty to convey and alienate, in fee simple or for any of Church less estate or interest, a piece of land situate in the Town of New Property.

Town, in Tasmania, containing Five acres One rood and Twelve 54 Vict. No. 8. perches or thereabouts, to the Trustees for the time being of the Property of the Church of England in Tasmania, such land being described in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE.

## TOWN OF NEW TOWN.

5a. 1r. 12p.

BOUNDED on the north west by 7 chains and 50 links north-easterly along land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution now known as the Archery Ground commencing at the south angle thereof (crossing a cart road), on the north east by 6 chains  $95\frac{1}{2}$  links south-easterly along the last-mentioned land and along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution (crossing a carriage drive), on the south east by 7 chains and  $44\frac{1}{2}$  links south-westerly also along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution, and thence on the south west by 7 chains and 13 links north-westerly also along other land belonging to the New Town Charitable Institution to the point of commencement.
