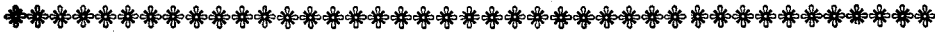

AN ACT to authorise the Issue of Treasury Bills to the amount of £25,000.

[27 December, 1872.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Governor may raise by the issue and sale of Treasury Bills any sums of money not exceeding in the whole Twenty-five thousand Pounds for the purpose of redeeming Treasury Bills to the amount of Twenty-five thousand Pounds falling due in the year 1873; and all such Treasury Bills shall be subject to the provisions of "The Treasury Bills Act, 1871," as fully in all respects as if the provisions of the said Act had been re-enacted in this Act.

Governor may raise £25,000 by issue of Treasury Bills.
