

AN ACT to amend The Launceston Corporation A.D. 1876. Act. [20 November, 1876.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an error in The Launceston 22 Vict. No. 12. Corporation Act, as to the exemption of certain property from Rates:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 The One hundred and fourth Section of The Launceston Repeal. Corporation Act is hereby repealed.
- 2 The Municipal Council shall not levy or raise any Rate whatever Certain property exempted from Rates.

Any lands or buildings the property of and occupied on behalf of Her Majesty:

Any lands or buildings hired or used by the Government of Tasmania for any public purpose:

Any Hospital, Benevolent Asylum, or other building used solely for charitable purposes:

Any Public Library or Public Museum:

Any Public School under the Board of Education:

Any church, chapel, or other building used solely for Public Worship.

3 This Act, and The Launceston Corporation Act, and all Acts Acts to be read amending the same, shall, save so far as the same may be altered or together. amended by any other Act or by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.
