AN ACT to amend the Law regulating Marriages.
[4 December, 1857.]

WHEREAS by the Act of Council of the 6th *Victoria*, No. 18, it is provided that before such Licence or Dispensation to marry without Banns as therein mentioned is granted or issued, and also before any Marriage is solemnized after the publication or republication of Banns as therein mentioned, and also before any Certificate is issued for the solemnization of any Marriage as therein mentioned, one of the parties seeking to contract Marriage shall make and subscribe, in manner therein mentioned, an Affidavit setting forth amongst other things that both of the said parties are free; and it is expedient to repeal so much of the said Act as requires that such Affidavit should set forth that the said parties are free: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that so much of the said Act of Council of the 6th *Victoria*, No. 18, as requires that any such Affidavit as aforesaid shall set forth that the parties seeking to contract Marriage are free, is hereby repealed.
