AN ACT to authorise the Minister of Lands and Works to expend a Sum not exceeding Four hundred and fifty Pounds out of moneys provided for the purpose of making Roads in accordance with the provisions of "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," in the vicinity of the *Lake* District, in and towards the construction of Rabbit-proof Fences in the same vicinity. [30 *October*, 1896.]

WHEREAS under and by virtue of "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," the Governor in Council is authorised to raise certain moneys by the issue and sale of Debentures so soon as Five hundred acres of land have been selected as therein mentioned for the purpose of making Roads in the vicinity of such land:

And whereas certain lands have been recently selected in the vicinity of the *Lake* District, and the selectors of such lands are desirous that a sum of money not exceeding Four hundred and fifty Pounds, which is now available by virtue of the said Act for the purpose of making Roads in the vicinity of such land should be expended by the Minister

of Lands and Works in and towards constructing Rabbit-proof Fences in the vicinity of such land in lieu of expending such money for the purpose of making Roads as aforesaid :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1**—(1.) It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works from time to time to expend any sum or sums of money not exceeding Four hundred and fifty Pounds out of moneys raised by the issue and sale of Debentures under the authority of Section One hundred and thirteen of “The Crown Lands Act, 1890,” for the purpose of making roads as therein mentioned, in and towards the construction of the whole or any part of the rabbit-proof fences set forth in the Schedule hereto.

Consent of

(2.) The said Minister shall not expend any money under the authority of this Act unless and until he has obtained the consent in writing of the majority of the selectors of Crown Land in the vicinity of whose land the said money would have been expended for the purposes of making roads as provided in the said Section.

Money expended

(3.) Any money expended by the said Minister under the authority of this Act shall be in lieu of and not in addition to any money authorised to be expended in making roads as provided by the said Section of the said Act.

**SCHEDULE.**

1. From a point on the eastern bank of the River Ouse opposite Lot 293 in a north-easterly direction to the River Shannon.
2. From a point on the eastern bank of the River Shannon about the south-west angle of Lot 885 in an easterly direction to the south-east angle of the Public Reserve, thence north-easterly to the south shore of the Lagoon of Islands.
3. From a point on the north side of the Lagoon of Islands at the south-west angle of Lot 10,356 northerly to a point on the south bank of the Upper Lake River.
4. The particular points defining the fencing and its boundaries shall be decided upon by the Chief Inspector of Stock.
