

AN ACT to authorise the Minister of Lands A.D. 1895. and Works to sell a certain piece of Land, and purchase other Land in lieu thereof. [24 October, 1895.]

W HEREAS it is desirable that the Minister of Lands and Works PREAMBLE. should be empowered to sell the piece of land situate near Hamiltonon-Forth, and now held by Trustees under the provisions of "The Recreation Grounds Act, 1888," and to purchase other land in lieu thereof:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works, at the Minister of Lands request of the Trustees of the piece of land which is particularly and Works may described in the Schedule hereto, and which is now held by the said sell. Trustees under the provisions of "The Recreation Grounds Act, 1888," to sell and convey the same in one or more lots to the purchaser or purchasers thereof.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to apply The Minister may and appropriate all or any portion of the moneys that may be received by him from the sale of the said piece of land in and to the purchase of land in Hamilton-on-Forth for the purposes of this Act.

Sale of Land, Hamilton-on-Forth.

Land purchased under this Act to be held under the provisions of 52 Vict. No. 17. 3 All land purchased by the Minister of Lands and Works, with all or any of the moneys received by him under the provisions of this Act, shall be under the care, control, and management of the Trustees appointed under "The Recreation Grounds Act, 1888," for the District of Forth, subject to the provisions of the said Act.

SCHEDULE.

FORTH RECREATION GROUND.

3 ACRES.

Bounded on the north by six chains easterly along land occupied by or belonging to William Jones commencing at a road, on the east by five chains southerly also along the last-mentioned land, on the south by six chains westerly along land occupied by or belonging to James Smith to the before-mentioned road, and thence on the west by five chains northerly along that road to the point of commencement.
