

AN ACT to authorise the Minister of Lands A.D. 1890. and Works to sell certain Lands, and to construct certain Public Works, and for [28 November, 1890.] other purposes.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 In this Act-
 - "The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the Interpretation. time being.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Minister, with the approbation of the Minister may sell Governor in Council, to sell by Public Auction, and not otherwise, the pieces of land mentioned in the Schedule (1). The said pieces of land shall previously to such sale be surveyed and delineated in the public charts of the Colony in such lots as are subsequently offered and put up for sale, in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by "The Crown Lands Act, 1890," for the sale of Town Lands under the said Act; and all the provisions of the said Act shall be applicable to the sale of the said pieces of land or any part thereof.

Sale of Lands, &c.

Vests certain Streets at New Norfolk in Her Majesty. 3 On and after the commencement of this Act the Streets at New Norfolk mentioned in the Schedule (2.) shall, to the extent therein set forth, become and be vested in Her Majesty, Her heirs and successors; and the said Streets shall thenceforth, to the extent set forth in the said Schedule (2.), cease to be public and common highways and thoroughfares, and may lawfully be enclosed by walls or otherwise, and appropriated to such purposes as Her Majesty or the Governor, acting on Her Majesty's behalf, shall deem expedient.

Works to be constructed.

4 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, completed, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the Schedule (3.), at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 applied.

5 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the said Schedule (3.), as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Appropriation of proceeds of sale of lands.

6 All sums of money received by the Treasurer on account of the sale of the Lands and Buildings mentioned in the Schedule (1.), or any part thereof, shall be appropriated for and towards defraying the cost of purchasing any Land under this Act, or all or any of the Works specified in the said Schedule (3).

1. Land and Buildings at Cascades, Hobart.

- 2. Land and Buildings at New Town, and known as the Government Farm.
- 3. Land and Buildings at Launceston, and known as the Launceston Gaol.
- 4. Land at Hobart, and known as the Brickfields Depôt.

(2.)

All that portion of Burnett-street extending south easterly from George-street to the Lachlan River.

All that portion of Grey-street extending south-westerly from the Lachlan River to Humphrey-street.
