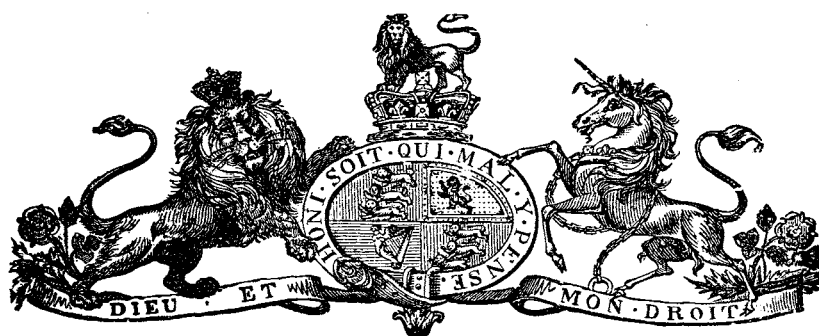

AN ACT to authorise the Minister of Lands and Works to vary a certain Agreement entered into on the Twenty-second day of *December*, 1892, with “*The Mount Dundas and Zeehan Railway Company, Limited.*”

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Notwithstanding anything contained in an Agreement made on the Twenty-second day of *December*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, between the Honorable *William Hartnoll*, being and as the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being of *Tasmania* of the one part, and “*The Mount Dundas and Zeehan Railway Company, Limited,*” of the other part, for the maintenance and working of the Railway of the Company, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, if he thinks fit, to make such arrangements as he may deem proper with the said Company for the maintenance and working of the Railway so as to provide for the traffic thereon, and no further. All such arrangements shall be for a period not exceeding Twelve months from the date of the passing of this Act.

Minister may arrange for falling off in traffic.
