AN ACT to alter the Name of the City of A.D. 1880. Hobart Town. [20 October, 1880.]

WHEREAS it is desirable that the name of the City of "Hobart PREAMBLE. Town" should be altered to " Hobart :"

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 On and after the First day of January, One thousand eight After 1st of hundred and eighty-one, the City called "Hobart Town" shall in all Acts of Parliament, and in all Deeds or other Instruments, and in all legal proceedings whatsoever be called and known by the name of City called "Hobart Hobart;" and no objection whatever shall after the said day be made "Hobart;" and no objection whatever shall after the said day be made "Hobart." or taken, or shall be of any validity or effect if made or taken, to the use of the word "Hobart" instead of the words "Hobart Town" in any deed instrument or proceeding whatever deed, instrument, or proceeding whatever.
