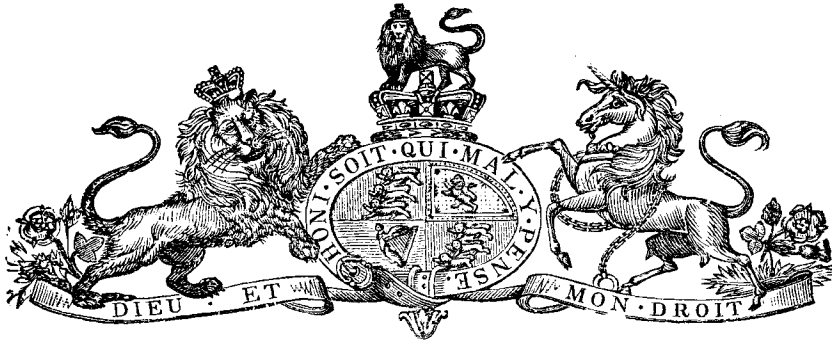

AN ACT to amend "The Promoters Enabling Act, 1892." [12 October, 1899.] A.D. 1899.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Promoters Enabling Act, 1892" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), in the manner hereinafter appearing: PREAMBLE. 56 Vict. No. 33.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The word "Company" used in the said Act shall include any person or Company incorporated or registered in accordance with law in any part of Her Majesty's dominions for the purpose of obtaining, acquiring, or carrying out the rights, powers, and privileges conferred by any of the Acts mentioned in the Schedule, and shall include the executors, administrators, and assigns of any such person, and the assigns of any such Company; but nothing in this Act shall in any way derogate from or prejudice any rights possessed by the Crown under the Acts mentioned in the Schedule hereto, or under any lease issued in pursuance of such Acts. Interpretation, "Company."

2 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
