ANALYSIS.

1. Council may pay £109 out of Municipal Fund.

AN ACT to authorise the Payment of certain Moneys by the Council of the Municipality of Westbury out of the Municipal Fund.

[16 December, 1929.]

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Westbury has PREAMBLE, found it expedient to discontinue the supply of water to the residents of Carrick and is disposing of the assets held in relation to the Carrick Water District:

And whereas after the disposal of such assets as aforesaid there is likely to be a debit balance in the accounts of the said Council relating to the said Carrick Water District amounting to a sum not exceeding One hundred and nine Pounds, which will constitute a iability on the part of the said Council, and the said Council has no unds in its hands out of which it can lawfully discharge such liability:

And whereas it is desirable to empower the said Council to pay the said sum out of the Municipal Fund:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Council may pay £109 out of Municipal Fund. 1 It shall be lawful for the said Council to pay out of the Municipal Fund of the said Municipality such amount not exceeding the sum of One hundred and nine Pounds as may be required for the purpose of making good the deficiency in the accounts relating to the said Carrick Water District and in satisfaction and discharge of such liability as aforesaid.
