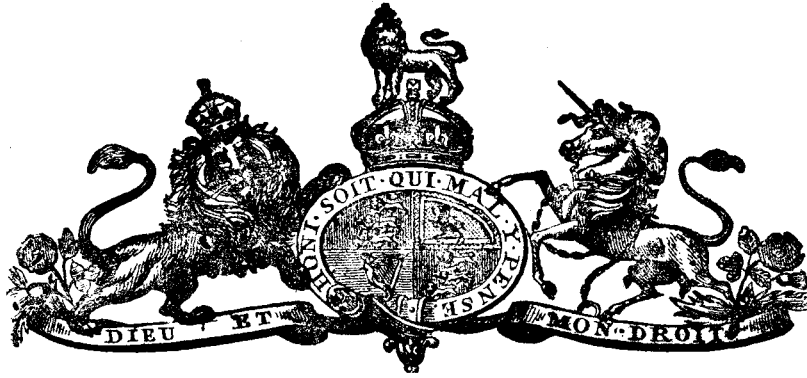

AN ACT to authorise the payment out of the Consolidated Revenue of the Sum of One thousand two hundred Pounds to *William Lewis Neale* upon his retirement from the Public Service of *Tasmania*.

WHEREAS *William Lewis Neale* was, on the First day of *January*, One thousand nine hundred and five, appointed Director of Education :

And whereas the said *William Lewis Neale* has agreed to retire from the Public Service of *Tasmania* upon receiving the sum of One thousand two hundred Pounds, and to accept the said sum in full satisfaction and discharge of all claims and demands whatsoever which he has or may have.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Appropriation.

**1** Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall be appropriated, issued, and applied, as hereinafter provided, for the service of the year ended the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and nine, for the purpose specified in the Schedule, the sum of One thousand two hundred Pounds.

**2** The Governor shall issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the said sum of One thousand two hundred Pounds to the said *William Lewis Neale*, and the said sum shall be paid by the Treasurer to the said *William Lewis Neale* upon his retirement from the Public Service of *Tasmania*.

**3** The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts for the said sum so paid by him in pursuance of the said warrant; and the receipt of the said *William Lewis Neale* shall be a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his said accounts for the said sum, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
