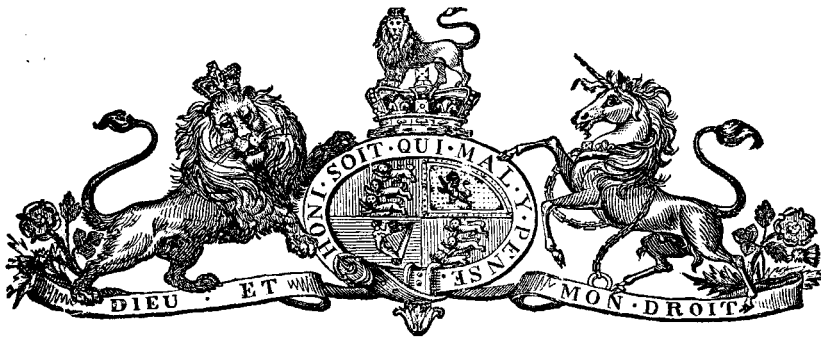

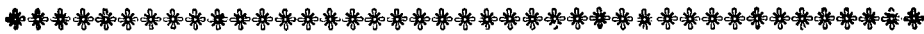

AN ACT to authorise the raising of £28,700 by Debentures chargeable on the Land Fund of *Tasmania* for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Year 1861.

[30 October, 1861.]

WHEREAS the estimated Revenue of the year 1861 is insufficient to meet the extraordinary Expenditure required for the year, and the sum of £28,700 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the Land Fund: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year 1861, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £28,700 in the whole by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of Parliament of *Tasmania*, 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say,—

Government may raise £28,700 by Debentures.

- As to the amount of £10,000 in the year 1874;
- As to the amount of £10,000 in the year 1875;
- As to the amount of £8,700 in the year 1876.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several sections, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repealed and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
