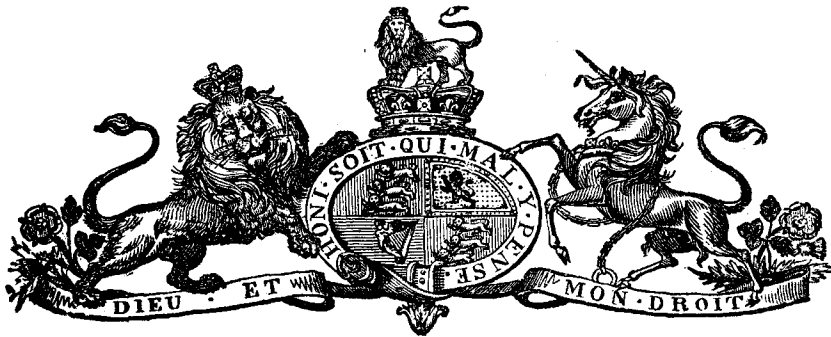

AN ACT to authorise the raising of £39,800, by Debentures chargeable on the Land Fund of *Tasmania*, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Year 1863.

[16 October, 1862.]

WHEREAS the estimated Revenue of the Year 1863 is insufficient to meet the extraordinary Expenditure required for the year, and the sum of £39,800 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the Land Fund: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Service of the year 1863, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised, a sum not exceeding £39,800 in the whole, by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of Parliament of *Tasmania*, 20 *Victoria*, No. 9, such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say,—

Government may raise £39,800 by Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several sections, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repealed and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
