

AN ACT to authorise the raising of a Sum not A.D. 1876. exceeding $\pounds 4700$ by Debentures. [20 November, 1876.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to raise a Sum not exceeding £4700 PREAMBLE. by Debentures, secured upon "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," for the purposes of this Act.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the issue and sale of Debentures, secured on "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 Victoria, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £4700, as may be required for the purposes set forth in the Schedule.

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable in the year 1884.

3 All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20 Victoria, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.
