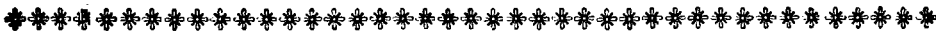

AN ACT to appoint the Registrar of the Supreme Court to be Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in the Colony of *Tasmania*.

[7th January, 1857.]

**W**HEREAS by the Act of Council of the Second *Victoria*, No. 8, **PREAMBLE.**  
it was enacted that it should be lawful for the Governor to provide a **2 Vict. No. 8.**  
proper Office in *Hobart Town*, to be called "The General Register Office," for keeping a Register of all Births, Deaths, and Marriages of Her Majesty's Subjects in this Island; and to appoint for the said Office, under the Seal of the Colony, a Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in this Colony: And whereas it is expedient that the Person holding the Office of Registrar of the Supreme Court should hereafter be, and perform the duties of, Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in this Colony; and that the Fees receivable by the said Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages, and by the Deputy Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages for the District of *Hobart Town* should henceforth form part of the General Revenue; and that the said recited Act should be amended accordingly: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Registrar of Supreme Court to be Registrar of Births, &c.

**1** On and after the First Day of *January*, 1857, the Person for the Time being holding the Office of Registrar of the Supreme Court of *Tasmania* shall be, and perform the Duties of, Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in this Colony; and "The General Register Office" for keeping a Register of all Births, Deaths, and Marriages in this Colony shall thenceforth be at the Office of the said Registrar of the said Court.

Fees received by Registrar and Deputy Registrar for *Hobart Town* to be paid into Treasury.

**2** On and after the said First Day of *January*, all Fees received by the Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages, and by the Deputy Registrar of Births, Deaths, and Marriages for the District of *Hobart Town* by virtue of such Offices, shall be paid by them into the Colonial Treasury, and form Part of the General Revenue.

Repeals Secs. 1 & 4 of 2 Vict. No. 8.

**3** On and after the said First Day of *January*, the First and Fourth Sections of the said recited Act shall be repealed.
