## No. 43.

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the \&um of $£ ீ 10,000$, by Debentures chargeable on the General Revenue of Tasmania, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Year 1863.
[29 September, 1863.]
$\mathbf{W}_{\text {hereas the estimated Revenue of the Year } 1883 \text { is is insufficient Pramansle. }}$ to meet the extraordinary Expenditure required for that year, and the sum of $£ 10,000$ is necessary to supply such deficiency in respect to the Defences of the Colony; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the General Revenue: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Government may Service of the year 1863, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding $£ 10,000$ in the whole by the raise $£ 10,000$ by issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, 20 Victoria, No. 9, such Debentures to bear Interest at a rate not exceeding Six Pounds per centum per annum, and to be redeemable as follows; that is to say,-

As to the amount of $£ 5000$ in the year 1883;
As to the amount of $£ 5000$ in the year 1884 .

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
