AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £10,000 on the Security of the General Revenue of Tasmania for the Purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due during the Year 1864. [29 September, 1863.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to borrow a sum PREAMBLE. of money not exceeding £10,000, on the security of the General Revenue, for the purpose of paying off Debentures falling due during the year 1864, under the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 For the purpose of paying off Debentures falling due during the Power to raise year 1864 under the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 20th £10,000 for pay-Victoria, No. 9, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause ingoff Debentures to be raised a Sum not exceeding £10,000 in the whole, by the issue and 20 Vict. No. 9. sale of Debentures secured upon the General Revenue in like manner as is prescribed in the said Act, and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding Six Pounds per centum per annum, and to be redeemable in the year 1878.

Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9 to apply to such Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act as fully and effectually, to all intents and purposes, as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in this Act.
