AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £15,900 by Debentures. [18 October, 1870.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £15,900 by Debentures, secured on the General Revenue and the Land Fund, for the purposes of this Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Sum or Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £13,900 as may be required for the following purposes :—

- (1.) As to the Sum of £13,100, for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the Year 1871 :
- (2.) As to the Sum of £800, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service for the Year 1866 and former Years :

And such Debentures shall be redeemable in the Year 1881.

Debentures, £15,900.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Sum or Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £2000 as may be required for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the Year 1871. And such Debentures shall be redeemable in the Year 1881.

3 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.
