

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £18,500, by Debentures chargeable on the Land Fund of *Tasmania*, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Years 1863, 1865, and 1866.

[20 February, 1867.]

W HEREAS the Revenue for the years 1863, 1865, and 1866 was PREAMBLE. insufficient to meet the ordinary Expenditure required for those years, and the sum of £18,500 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the Land Fund: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the Government may service of the years 1863, 1865, and 1866, it shall be lawful for the raise £18,500 by Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £18,500 Debentures. Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £18,500 in the whole by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, 20th Victoria, No. 9; and the Debentures to be issued by virtue of this Act shall be redeemable in the year 1870.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, Provisions of 20 and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and apply to such extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as Debentures, fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
