

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of $\pounds 20,800$ by Debentures. [21 December, 1871.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £20,800 by PREAMBLE. Debentures, secured on the Public Revenues of the Colony, for the purposes of this Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by the Power to raise issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Public Revenues of the £20,800 by Colory in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th Victoria No. 9 Debentures. Colony, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th Victoria, No. 9, such sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole £20,800 as may be required for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the Year 1872; and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the Year 1882.

2 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of 20 No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in Vict. No. 9, to be pursuance of this Act.
