

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £27,000 by Debentures.

[17 September, 1868.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £27,000 by PREAMBLE. Debentures, secured on the General Revenue and the Land Fund, for the purposes of this Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised Governor in by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in Council may raise £11,300 by Sum or Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £11,300, as General Revenue. may be required for the following purposes:-

- (1.) As to the Sum of £8500, for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the Year 1869:
- (2.) As to the Sum of £2800, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service for the Year 1866 and former Years:

And such Debentures shall be redeemable in the Year 1874.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised Governor in by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like Council may manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th Victoria, No. 9, such Sum or raise £15,700 by

Debentures, £27,000.

Debentures on Land Fund.

Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £15,700, as may be required for the following purposes:—

- (1.) As to the Sum of £8700, for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the Year 1869:
- (2.) As to the Sum of £7000, for making good the deficiency on the Sale of Debentures for Public Works issued under the authority of *The Public Works Loans Act*, 1865:

And such Debentures shall be redeemable in the Year 1876.

20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such Debentures.

3 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.
