AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum A.D. 1873. of £45,500 by Debentures. [25 July, 1873.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £45,500, by PREAMBLE. Debentures secured upon the Public Revenues of the Colony of Tasmania, for the purposes of this Act :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the Governor may issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Public Revenues of the raise £45,500 by Debentures Colony, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 Victoria, No. 9, Debentures. such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £45,500, as may be required for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the year 1874, as follows :---

> £30,100 due in London, £15,400 due in Tasmania.

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at a rate not exceeding Debentures to Five Pounds per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable in the year 1878.

**3** All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be raised in 20 Vict. No. 9, the provision of the contract pursuance of this Act.
