AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of A.D. 1875.
£46,500 by Debentures. [30 September, 1875.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £46,500, by Debentures secured upon "The Consolidated Revenue Fund" of the Colony of *Tasmania*, for the purposes of this Act: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on "The Consolidated Revenue Fund," in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 *Victoria*, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £46,500, as may be required for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the year 1876, as follows:— Governor may raise £46,500 by Debentures.

£14,100 due in *London*,
£32,400 due in *Tasmania*.

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at a rate not exceeding Five Pounds per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable as follows:— Rate of Interest and date of redemption.

As to the sum of £10,000 in the year 1881.
As to the sum of £10,000 in the year 1882.
As to the sum of £26,500 in the year 1883.

3 All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act. Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9, to be applicable.
