AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of A.D. 1875. £46,500 by Debentures. [30 September, 1875.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £46,500, by PREAMBLE. Debentures secured upon "The Consolidated Revenue Fund" of the Colony of *Tasmania*, for the purposes of this Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,

by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised, by the Governor may issue and sale of Debentures secured on "The Consolidated Revenue raise £46,500 by Fund," in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20 Victoria, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £46,500, as may be required for the purpose of redeeming certain Debentures falling due in the year 1876, as follows :---

> £14,100 due in London, £32,400 due in Tasmania.

2 All such Debentures shall bear Interest at a rate not exceeding Rate of Interest Five Pounds per centum per annum, and shall be redeemable as and date of redemption. follows :-

> As to the sum of £10,000 in the year 1881. As to the sum of £10,000 in the year 1882. As to the sum of $\pounds 26,500$ in the year 1883.

3 All provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in 20 Vict. No. 9, to be applicable. pursuance of this Act.
