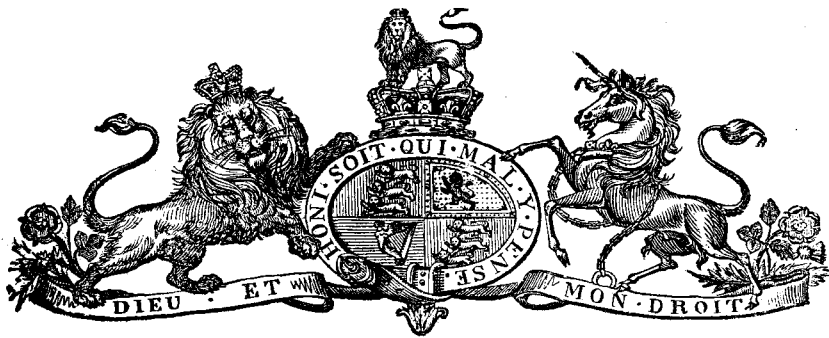

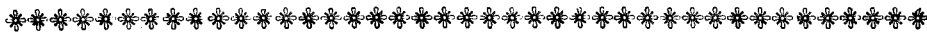

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £8800 by Debentures chargeable on the General Revenue of *Tasmania*, for making good the Supplies for the Public Service in the Year 1862. [29 September, 1863.]

WHEREAS the estimated Revenue for the year 1862 was insufficient to meet the extraordinary Expenditure for that year, and the sum of £8800 is necessary to supply such deficiency; and it is expedient to raise such sum by Loans secured on the General Revenue: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 For the purpose of making good the supplies appropriated to the public service of the year 1862, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £8800 in the whole, by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, and bearing Interest at a rate not exceeding Six Pounds *per centum per annum*, and to be redeemable in the year 1881.

Power to raise £8800 by Debentures secured on the General Revenue.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several sections, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
