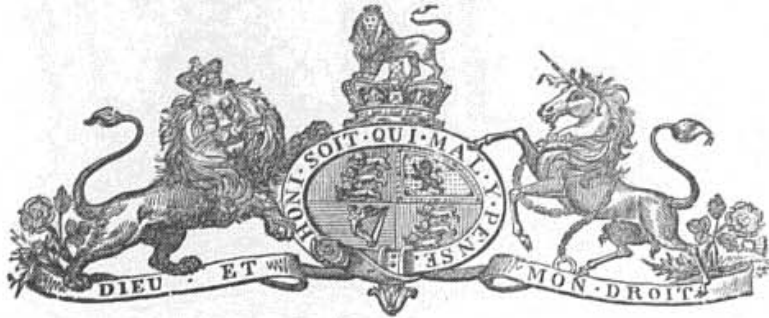

AN ACT to authorise the Supreme Court to hold
Criminal Sittings during the long Vacation.

[25 February, 1858.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that Sessions of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery of the Supreme Court of *Tasmania* may lawfully be commenced and holden before One or more of the Judges of the said Court between the Tenth day of *February* and the Twenty-fourth day of *April* in every year, at such times and places as the said Judges think fit to appoint, any Law to the contrary notwithstanding.
