3 The Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being by any Warrant or Order in writing to be signed by him shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the General Revenue of the said Colony.

4 The said Treasurer shall in his Accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Order or Warrant in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
