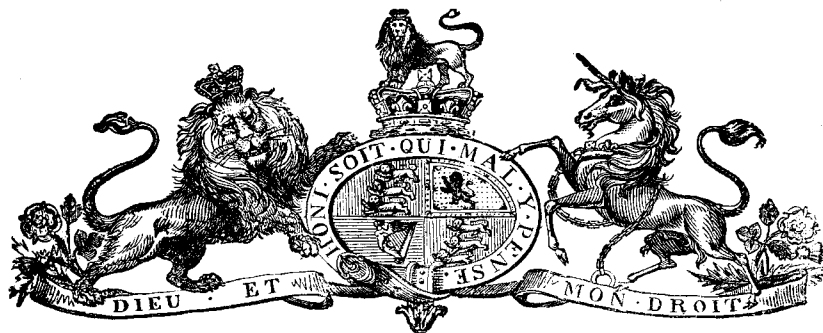

AN ACT to appropriate the Sum of Three thousand Pounds from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes of the Defences of the Colony of *Tasmania*, for the Year commencing on the First day of *July*, 1887, and ending on the Thirtieth day of *June*, 1888. [20 *December*, 1887.] A.D. 1887.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, for the Service of the Year commencing on the First day of *July*, 1887, and ending on the Thirtieth day of *June*, 1888, for the purposes of the Defences of the Colony of *Tasmania*, the sum of Three thousand Pounds. Appropriation of £3000 for Defence purposes.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from Moneys payable by Warrant of Governor.

Credit to be given
to the Treasurer
in Account.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
