AN ACT to authorise the Trustees for the A.D. 1889. time being of the Property of the Presbyterian Church of Tasmania to select an Allotment of Land in the County of Devon, in lieu of an Allotment of Land in the Town of Formby specially reserved for the purposes of the Church of Scotland.

[26 September, 1889.]

WHEREAS an allotment of land containing Five acres Two PREAMBLE. roods and Sixteen perches, in the Town of Formby, appears by the Parliamentary Journals of the House of Assembly, 1866 and 1868, Papers numbered respectively 46 and 83, to have been specially reserved for the purposes of the Church of Scotland:

And whereas the said land has been resumed by the Crown, and the Trustees of the Property of the Presbyterian Church of Tasmania have applied to be empowered to select an allotment of land in the County of Devon, in Tasmania, in lieu of the said allotment resumed as aforesaid, and that a Grant for such land may be issued to the said Trustees:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

### Land for Presbyterian Church Trustees.

Trustees may select and Governor grant 5 acres 2 roods 16 perches of land.

1-(1.) It shall be lawful for James Thomas Robertson, Samuel Tulloch, Alexander Webster, Donald MacKinnon, and Donald MacMillan, as Trustees for the time being of the Property of the Presbyterian Church of Tasmania, to select, subject to the approbation of the Governor in Council, and within a year from the date of the passing of this Act, Five acres Two roods and Sixteen perches of the Waste Lands of the Crown in the County of Devon, in Tasmania, in lieu of an allotment of land in the Town of Formby specially reserved for the purposes of the Church of Scotland.

(2.) The Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, under and subject to the various provisions contained in *The Waste Lands Act*, and every amendment thereof, and any Regulations made and published thereunder, to convey and alienate such land as may be selected as aforesaid to the said *James Thomas Robertson, Samuel Tulloch, Alexander Webster, Donald MacKinnon*, and *Donald MacMillan*, as Trustees as aforesaid, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

(3.) Such land shall be vested in the said James Thomas Robertson, Samuel Tulloch, Alexander Webster, Donald MacKinnon, and Donald MacMillan, for the benefit of the said Church, and the same shall be subject to all the provisions of "The Presbyterian Church Act" and "The Presbyterian Church Amendment Act, 1882."
