AN ACT to amend *The Volunteer Corps Act.*
[1 February, 1862.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend *The Volunteer Corps Act*: PREAMBLE.
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, 22 Vict. No. 11.
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House
of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 The Governor may, by Commission under his hand and seal, appoint Field Officers to any one or more Volunteer Corps. Governor may appoint Field Officers to Corps.
- 2 Every Volunteer Corps shall be subject to be inspected once at least in every Six months, by some Officer or retired Officer of Her Majesty's regular Forces who may be appointed by the Governor for such purpose. Corps subject to be inspected by Officers of regular Forces.
- 3 Section 9 of *The Volunteer Corps Act* is hereby repealed. Repeals Sect. 9 of 22 Vict. No. 11.
- 4 This Act and *The Volunteer Corps Act*, save so far as the same is altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read together.
