AN ACT to amend The Volunteer Corps Act. [1 February, 1862.]

HEREAS it is expedient to amend The Volunteer Corps Act: PREAMBLE. Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, 22 Vict. No. 11. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 The Governor may, by Commission under his hand and seal, Governor may appoint Field Officers to any one or more Volunteer Corps.

2 Every Volunteer Corps shall be subject to be inspected once at Corps subject to least in every Six months, by some Officer or retired Officer of Her be inspected by Majesty's regular Forces who may be appointed by the Governor for Officers of regular Forces. such purpose.

3 Section 9 of The Volunteer Corps Act is hereby repealed.
