

AN ACT to amend "The Zeehan Railway A.D. 1889. Construction Act, 1889." [9 November, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Zeehan Interpretation. 52 Vict. No. 56. Railway Construction Act, 1889."

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be expended upon Additional the construction and completion of the Line of Railway to be called expenditure for "The Zeehan Railway," a sum not exceeding Seventy thousand Pounds, such sum to be in addition to the sum of Sixty thousand Pounds authorised to be expended by the said Act.

3 The whole of the moneys authorised to be expended by this Act Defrayment of shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for cost of Works. that purpose.

4 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be Acts to be read read and construed together as one Act.
